THE MAN WHO DROPPED OUT OF CHURCH! Acts 20:7-12

- 7 On the first day of the week we came together to break bread. Paul spoke to the people and, because he intended to leave the next day, kept on talking until midnight.
- 8 There were many lamps in the upstairs room where we were meeting.
- 9 Seated in a window was a young man named Eutychus, who was sinking into a deep sleep as Paul talked on and on. When he was sound asleep, he fell to the ground from the third story and was picked up dead.
- 10 Paul went down, threw himself on the young man and put his arms around him. "Don't be alarmed," he said. "He's alive!"
- 11 Then Paul went upstairs again and broke bread and ate After talking until daylight, Paul left.
- 12 The people took the young man home alive and were greatly comforted.

"EUTYCHUS WAS A GOOD MAN!
"EUTYCHUS" means "good man," "fortunate"

EUTYCHUS WAS IN A GOOD CHURCH!

- 1. Lots of good preaching ! (vs 7 & 11)
- 2. Lots of good fellowship I (vs 7 & 11)

WHY DID EUTYCHUS FALL ASLEEP?

1. It was late (vs 7)
(A church's schedule can wear you out)

- 2. There were many smoky lamps (vs 8)
 (Christians give off smoke! II Cor 2:14-16))
 (There are things we do that make good people fall asleep!)
- 3. He was sitting on the window sill (vs 9)
 (Not everybody CAN or WILL fit on the front row)
 (There are many good people sitting on the sidelines)
- 4. Paul preached very long (vs 9)
 (Not everybody hangs onto every word of the preacher)

WHAT WAS NEEDED TO MINISTER TO A DEAD EUTYCHUS?

Eutychus required Supernatural Power and Personal Attention.

WHO MINISTERED TO EUTYCHUS? "The PEOPLE took the young man home!" (vs 12) (Paul left town!)

PAUL WAS NOT A VERY GOOD PASTOR!

- 1. He did not pray with the man I
- He may have spent 30 seconds with the man in the spent 30 seconds with the spent 30 seconds with the man in the spent 30 seconds with the spent 30 s
- 4. He talked until morning and left town !

NOTE:

The church body MUST minister to its own!
The preachers can NOT do it all.

Honor and respect your ministers.
Recognize how God moves powerfully through them,
but minister to people as if the preachers are leaving the next day!

When the preachers are gone, the church body MUST minister to its own!
